More people need to be encouraged/invited to help with the plan. Someone is needed to talk to the clubs. A flyer is needed to ask broad, open questions – Does the Village matter to you? What are your issues? What is your vision in 5, 10, 20 years? After feedback from a flyer we would be able to go on with a survey. It was discussed that the Project Plan would probably take 18 months.

Children will be invited to design name/logo for the Plan. This needs to be done as soon as possible. Action: JJeffs.

PR and SR would be able to approach the Cricket Club, Joan Johnson the WI Stakeholder plan needed before businesses approached. Events coming up before Christmas – Christmas Fair, Cricket Club AGM, Rural Touring Network.
